- Dry rush must be observed during the designated rush period, as determined by the PFC Legislative Association per the resolution it passed the semester before. This resolution may be found on the PFC website.
- “No council shall be permitted to extend pledge activities for longer than 8 class weeks. All pledging activities must be concluded at least two full weeks prior to the last scheduled day of classes for the semester and may not extend pledging programs from one semester into another including summer session.”
- The attached pledge letter must be distributed to your pledge class within the first week of pledge and may not be altered or redacted in any way.
- All anti-hazing regulations as described in the BU Governance Recognition & Governance Document, BU Student Code of Conduct, PFC By-Laws, and PFC resolutions must be observed at all times.
- Please also complete any additionally provided Binghamton University pledge forms, so they may forward to the Office of Fraternity/Sorority Affairs if the request such forms to be completed.
- This form must be submitted to the PFC Chief Magistrate by the third week of your pledging.
